Mission with Children in Romania

A few months back Mary Ferris talked about the NOROC Program. This is a program that was started by Dr. Fred White and his wife to help support the orphan children of Romania. After her talk, several from Westminster asked how you could help. She identified several items and said we have a chance to get involved with two of them. The following is her request.

First, for all of the orphans, very young children to the older teens, Mary said, "Please help us get some watches. They don't have to be new; they don't have to be pretty; they just need to work." We all know from personal experience that a watch can make us feel important, grown up, in control, responsible, and in charge.

Most of us have "that drawer" where we toss discarded watches, watches that are too small for us, etc. You can clean out that drawer and help the orphans at the same time. Also, should you want to purchase one or more watches, many grocery and discount stores have some very inexpensive watches. If you purchase, please keep it simple and inexpensive. Bring whatever you can find, spare, or purchase to the church starting this Sunday and drop them into the box in the lobby. A group of people will be going to Romania in June who will take the watches for distribution.

Second, Mary asked for coloring books. Again, they can be new or partially used. If partially used, please cut out the used pictures. They can be religious or not, but must not have a violent theme. Drop them in the box in the lobby for coloring books and watches and they, too, will get to Mary and the orphans in Romania.

Deadline will be Sunday, June 10th. Don't miss out on this opportunity to make a difference.
